

As of 2017, Cuba is spending 8.6% --the OECD average-- of their GDP to achieve nearly identical health outcomes to the medical system of the United States which uses greater than 17% of its GDP for health-care expenditures. No other country spends as much on healthcare per person or in total yet our life expectancy is either stagnating or falling every year and remains less than that of nearly every country with a modern nationalized healthcare system.



Socialist policies in Vietnam have lead to a far more inclusive environment for those living with disabilities. In the US, according to the Bureau of Labor and Statistics, just 19.3% of those with disabilities are employed. In Vietnam where the government has undertaken initiatives to create jobs and vocational training programs explicitly for people with disabilities 86% of these people are employed.
