The CPUSA was founded in 1919, and took several organizational forms in its lifetime. However, revisionism and opportunism in the Party laid the seeds for the degeneration of the CPUSA as a Marxist-Leninist Party.

Gorbachev's Glasnost and Perestroika, planted the seeds of social democracy in the international Communist Movement.

The Communist Party in America was also affected, especially after the Counter-Revolution of 1991.

A sizeable anti-Party Faction led by Angela Davis walked out of the 1991 CPUSA Convention and set up a Social Democratic formation called the Committees of Correspondence.

After the death of General Secretary Gus Hall, the CPUSA was taken over by a liquidationist clique led by Sam Webb, John Bachtell, Joe Sims, and Rosanna Cambron The National Council of
Communists USA (NCCUSA) was
founded as a pre-party
formation to set up a new
Marxist-Leninist Party in the
United States. Members studied
Marxist-Leninist ideology in
Staten Island on the premise
that the CPUSA was deserting its
revolutionary and

Marxist-Leninist Ideology that a principled Marxist-Leninist party was needed.
By 2013 the NCCUSA had created multiple commissions, departments, a constitution, a newspaper, and a theoretical organ.



The NCCUSA formed ties with other international Communist Parties, (Russia, Spain, Mexico) On May Day 2015, several dozen leading NCCUSA members voted to become a Leninist party.

8 Points of Unity

Points of unity were established under the direction of the NCCUSA which established the Party's Constitution. In 2016, the PCUSA held its first Party Congress at Arrow Park in Monroe New York.

The Party of Communists USA intends to continue the legacy and ideology of the former CPUSA led by William Z. Foster and Gus Hall. The History Commission will continue to dive into the history of the old CPUSA and connect it our current state in history.
