# THE CULPRITS

According to the Carbon  
Disclosure Project Carbon  
Majors Report 2017, 100  
companies are  
responsible for 71% of  
global emissions which  
are a direct cause for the  
increase in global heat  
index. This large chunk of  
global emissions has a  
direct link to rapid  
climate change.



## MONEY OVER ENVIRONMENT

ExxonMobil, Shell, BP,  
Chevron - are among the  
highest emitting privately-  
owned companies since  
1988. If fossil fuels continue  
to be extracted at the same  
rate as the period between  
1988-2017, global average  
temperatures could rise by  
7.2°F by the end of the  
century. This would have  
catastrophic consequences  
including species extinction  
and global food scarcity  
risks.
